The Jersey International Future Skills Framework (JIFS) qualification aims to provide students from the Highlands College Sixth Form with skills, knowledge and experiences which will enhance opportunities post-College and be advantageous to future success.

Although this qualification is owned by and unique to Jersey, it has been developed in partnership with City & Guilds, drawing on international best practice from jurisdictions including Finland, Germany, and Canada. The JIFS qualification has been validated and co-written by both the Institute of Leadership and Management (ILM) and City and Guilds. The framework will meet Level 3 (A-Level equivalent) benchmarks and OECD 2030 future learning competencies.

Sitting alongside our existing Level 3 provision the course will take a total of 180 hours to complete, and will facilitate student planning, action, and reflection through an instructive coaching model.

Assessments will be competency-based with practical, project-based, micro credentials awarded at bronze, silver and gold level.

For each module successfully completed, students will receive a City and Guilds or ILM digital credential to be used on LinkedIn or included in a digital portfolio of evidence to carry with them into their future careers.

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
