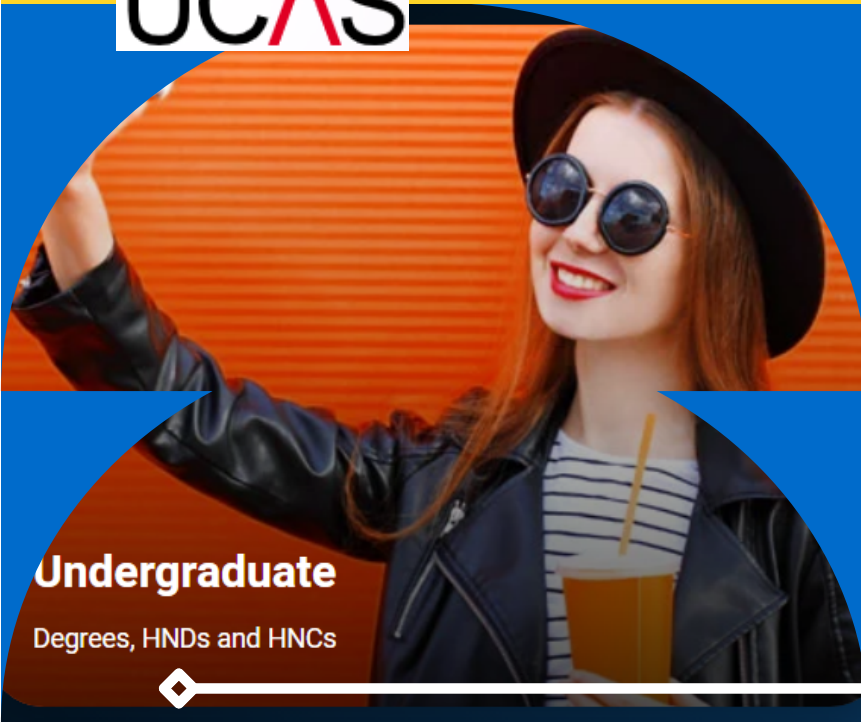

Student Finance Information Evenings

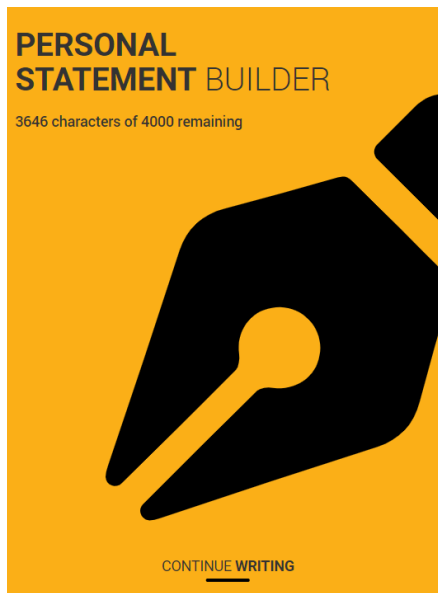

If you just want to do some research, that's ok too as you don't need to have an account to access some areas of the UCAS website.



You do need to have a HUB account to access the Personal Statement Builder. This is a fantastic resource and will help you to include everything that Universities are looking for when offering students a place. You should be prepared to do at least two drafts before you are happy to include it in your application.

You can email a draft of your personal statement to employability@highlands.ac.uk whenever you are ready to get some feedback, and as many

times as you need. Remember, your personal statement could be the difference between you and someone else getting that last place on the course you want!
