## SUMMARY

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2019, 40 elected members in the States Assembly voted to declare, “that there exists a climate emergency likely to have a profound effect in Jersey”.

## Why?

- As a species, we continue to consume, pollute, and waste like there’s no tomorrow. And our days certainly will be numbered if we don’t act now and make sustainability a way of life.
- Over 75% of waste is recyclable, but only about 30% of it is recycled.
- 1.3 billion tons of food is wasted worldwide every year. Just one-quarter of this could feed 795 million undernourished people.
- Scientists warn that even if all the Paris emissions commitments were met, temperatures would surpass 1.5°C warming, and increase by 3°C to 5°C by 2100. The last time the world was that hot was 15 million years ago during the Miocene. At this temperature, seas could rise by more than 2 metres this century as more than <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> of the world’s glaciers melt.
