WHAT IS A DBS CHECK?

- It is a record held by Police of an individual's convictions, cautions, reprimands and warnings.
- It relates to your suitability for a position working with children and vulnerable adults.
- It costs a £45 one off payment.
- It is compulsory for your course at Highlands College.

WHAT IS THE UPDATE SERVICE?

- It is an online subscription that keeps your DBS check up to date.
- It allows employers to check a certificate online.
- It costs £13 per year.
- You will have an access to your Update Service account.

If you have applied for a Childcare, Health or Sport & Uniformed Services course, a satisfactory enhanced DBS check and the Update Service are requirements of your course.



STEP 1: REGISTER AT HOME

- You must be 16 or over to register
- Please use the link below to register for your Enhanced DBS check online:

- You will need the following information: Org PIN – 162133
 Secret Word – Highlands
 Your personal email address
- When applying online the following documents are required:
 - 1. A current and valid Passport or Driving Licence
 - 2. British and Jersey Birth Certificate or Jersey Registration Card
 - 3. Proof of address
- If you were born in Jersey, type St Helier as 'place of birth'

STEP 2: VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

- You will be able to verify your documents during the first week of the academic term in September
- You will be required to bring the documents that you declared in STEP 1

STEP 3: PAYMENT OF THE DBS CHECK

• Payment MUST be done online by the applicant, at home. In order to pay the £45 fee please log in to your DBS application via this link

STEP 4: UPDATE SERVICE

 You MUST join the Update Service after you receive your Certificate in post. Use this website https://secure.crbonline.gov.uk/crsc/apply to enter the details and pay £13 per annum for your subscription.
